- Target Date of Early 2006
- Principle of Subsidiarity
- Recommendation .v. Regulation/Directive
- Broad Principles for implementing ICZM



# Stocktake – An Identification Process

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- Identify Sectors
- Identify Legislation
- Identify Players/Institutions/Key Bodies
- Identify Roles/Jurisdictions
- Existing Consultation/Coordination Processes



# Stocktake – An Identification Process

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- Identify overlaps or gaps in these processes
- Existing Public Consultation/ Participation Processes or Practices
- Identify Key Issues for Institutions/Players/Stakeholders
- Target to complete within 2004.
